LIONS CLUB OF NAIROBI CARGEN KISII SIGHT RESTOTATION TOUR.



Of the 7.5 million people in Kenya who have problems related to vision loss and impairment, only 1.6 million have access to effective eye care services. Yet only 75% of these eye diseases can be treated to prevent sight loss. We set out to Kisii to improve the quality of the lives of the people we could reach who were affected by various vision challenges, while making our contribution towards preventing blindness.

From 5th to 8th of June 2023, Lions Club of Nairobi Cargen, together with Lions Sight First hospital and with the support of Car & General held an eye Camp in Kisii as follows:

- 5th July 2023 - Suneka eye clinic and screening at Iyabe Sub County Hospital
We screened 53 patients, 2 were referred to Kisii Teaching and Referral Hospital and 11 were issued with glasses.
- 6th July 2023 - Ogembo eye clinic and screening at Gucha Sub County Referral Hospital
We screened 225 patients, 10 were cataract patients, 2 were booked for surgery at KTRH while one 5 year old was referred to LSFH Nairobi.
- 7th July 2023 Kisii town with an eye clinic and screening at Kisii Stadium for boda boda riders and their families.

On day 3, despite being plagued by the maandamano wave, we screened 101 people, 8 cataract surgeries were done with 2 additional cataract patients seen. 2 patients' surgeries were rejected due to high blood pressure.

Some cataract surgeries were rescheduled for 8th July because some patients did not turn up due to maandamano. In total, we were able to cater for 28 cataract surgeries at the Kisii Teaching and Referral Hospital.
